



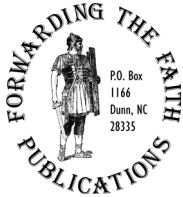

Dr. O. Talmadge Spence (1926-2000) was the founder and first president of the Foundations Bible Collegiate Church, Schools, and Ministries, which began in 1974. During his almost fifty years of preaching and teaching the Holy Scriptures, Dr. Spence wrote forty-eight books, booklets and tracts, eleven oratorios, two cantatas, and over three hundred hymns. Crucial Truths for Crucial Days is a compilation of articles taken from “Straightway,” the published voice of the Christian Purities Fellowship, an outreach arm of Foundations Bible College.

The word *crucial* in its primary meaning suggests something critical, severe, or trying. Its secondary meaning, “cross-shaped,” actually stems from the Latin term for *cross*. The author believes we are living in the most

crucial days of human history; these days are critical, trying, and severe.

The Bible has prophesied that the days before the coming of the Lord will be filled with global apostasy marked by a falling away within the institutional church. Therefore, the triumphing truths of the Cross become a greater necessity for the biblical Christian life in such times. Beginning in 1952, Dr. O. Talmadge Spence began a life-long study and acquisition of notes from studies of the Bible. Anvil House (softback; 1997, Foundations Press, 70 pages). This book was written for the day of dedication of Anvil House, May 15, 1997. It serves as an introduction to this Christian learning center located on the central campus of Foundations Bible College. With a brief explanation of the vision, purpose, and description of the facility, the majority of the book is given to the need of remembering history as it really happened. Chapter titles include “Form and Freedom,” “Jesus Through the Centuries,” “Patrons of the Holy Catholic Church,” “History of Architectural Form,” and “A House of Worship.” An epic poem by the same title, also written by the author for the day of dedication, commences the book. Tours of

the Anvil House facility are encouraged, and prior perusal of this book would make such a tour more meaningful to the visitor.

The Divine Interlude (softback; 1999, Ambassador-Emerald, Intl., 417 pages). *The Divine Interlude* is the only novel written by Dr. O. Talmadge

Spence. The story is a contemporary romance of a couple who are joined together in love and in the truth of God's Word. Every step in their journey of life is directed toward God. The story begins in 1947 and expands into the twenty-first century, 2007. Not only do you read about an ideal romance of a couple destined to live a determinedly separated life unto God, but also you will gain an abundance of knowledge. Subjects such as historic Christianity, modern apostasy, doctrine, ecumenism, eternity, ethics, evangelism, fundamentalism, history, music, art aesthetic, science, and separation are addressed and discussed in depth. *The Divine Interlude* presents a couple, then a family, as the ideal of Christianity in search of the very real. The story is credible. The facts are credible. It is a needed view of the changes of historic Christianity by modern man.\$12.95

The Eclipse of Hope (softback; 1995, Foundations Press, 83 pages).

A philosophical approach to the need of a change in the methods of evangelism, because there has been a change in the presupposition of the audience. With the growing apostasy among Christian churches, there are more atheists and agnostics present from the fall-out. \$4.95

apologetic epic poem of an imaginary little angel who was assigned to be an observer in eight periods of history since Creation. The author sounds the needed warning concerning “the extremes to which some theological systems have taken the teaching of sanctification. . . . These extremes include *antinomianism* at one end of the pendulum and *legalism* at the other end. We must guard against such extremes which produced errors.... Sin is always possible, but sin is never a necessity. All of our individual distinctives must fall within these boundaries, or else we shall defeat the hope of a holy life at all in Christ Jesus.” \$4.95

The Holy Spirit in Heaven and Earth (softback; 1997, Foundations Press, 177 pages). This book represents the need of the Holy Spirit in the lives of Christians in the times in which we live. It commences with Adam and Eve at the border of sin in the Garden and proceeds through the Bible to the border of heaven and the New Jerusalem City. The subjects through which the author takes the reader in this study of the Holy Spirit include Suffering, Sin, the Trinity, the Holy Scriptures, the Holy Spirit Phenomena, God’s Love, Worship, the Altar, and finally, Heaven. . . \$8.95

The Lord’s Song in a Timely Music Primer (softback; 1997, Foundations Press, 138 pages). This Primer is launched in our contemporary time with the hope and prayer for the young who must study music again as generations did before us. We must maintain an exodus from the present generation of slob-culture as well as the religious entertainments in most churches. Next to a Bible pulpit, there is the need of a sanctified choir, both free from the charismatic clowns and clashes heard so often in many worship and preaching services. The songs span his lifetime from the 1950’s to 1997. The songs express many different subjects from the biblical to the secular, from the eternal God to natural love, in song forms from the anthem to the ballad. *The Message of Sacred Song* can be used as a supplemental hymnal for the church. Soloists and group singers can use it for special singing. The music can be played for preludes and interludes in church services. The book may simply be read for instructional and devotional moments. The musician
